Weights cannot be below the minimum. For classes listing multiple weights and an *, there is a weight variance offered for different engines. Fast-lap times were first recorded in 1998. The course record is 31.084, by Austin Wilkins, Texas, in the '16 feature of the King of the Streets (125cc Open Shifter).
